21/10/111 Tactile Paving, Muxton

To discuss the condition of the tactile paving (also called detectable warning surface) for the visually impaired and agree an action plan for betterment. I believe these areas have not been designed or installed strictly in accordance with the official guidance, plus the standards of reinstatement to meet the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 are dubious.

21/10/112 Hedge encroachment on footpaths

To discuss how the Parish Council can support Cllr Iain Alexander to obtain resolution on his FOI and ongoing Appeal with T&WC regarding the legal advice given to TWC Environment Officers to keep public footpaths safe, clear of obstructions and encroachment by private property. This is particularly important in the era of keeping your distance due to COVID 19 and maintaining the “highway” it was designed for i.e. the whole width of the footpath.

21/10/113 Litter Bins on Fieldhouse Drive

To discuss installing two extra bins between Muxton Lane and Meadow Road as there are none currently along this stretch of road.
