P21/11/14 Planning Applications

Councillors discussed the following planning applications.

a. TWC/2021/0995

Mr & Mrs H Breep, 1 Pembridge Close, Muxton, Telford, Shropshire.

Change of use of open space to private garden land, erection of an up to 1.985m high boundary wall and 0.78m metal railings *** Amended description ***

Resolved – to comment that whilst the Parish Council has no objection to this application it would like the two trees retained.

b. DMMO/2003/0002

Jan Mees-Robinson, Granville Roundabout, Donnington. Telford, Shropshire.

To add a restricted byway along Grange Lane.

Councillors were concerned that there would be an increase in criminal activity and the adverse effect the byway would have on the horses and livestock situated in and around it.

Resolved – to object to this application as Councillors felt that more localised consultation is required.

c. TWC/2021/1006

Mathew Pike, 13 The Fields, Donnington, Telford, Shropshire.

Erection of a two-storey rear extension.

d. DMMO/2010/0001

Glyn Bowen, 9 Copperfield Drive, Muxton, Telford, Shropshire.
Add a footpath from Copperfield Drive to Marshbrook Way.
